WHO TO WATCH

PART 1

Men's B Grade: Mount Lawley vs Baldivis

Sasha Kurnutt, Stuart Guest, Nic Farmer and Campbell Abbott have been named as players to watch from Mount Lawley. Kurnutt, a previous premierships player is a “silky player who will have familiarity of the ground,” said Mount Lawley Coach Craig Hayden. “Guest has a bright future... is tenacious and does not take a backward step. Farmer has come on this year, is a vital cog to the well-oiled midfield... and influential in transition. Abbott is one of our smartest footballers... he is an integral part to the back 7 with his communication and experience.”

From the Baldivis bench, Emmanuel ‘Manny’ Collard, Eddy Dann, and Tyson Powell, are three players to keep your eyes peeled for on Saturday.

“As Baldivis’ captain and central midfielder, Collard consistently finds plenty of the footy and sets the tone for the team’s engine room,” said a representative from Baldivis. “[He] will be crucial in controlling the midfield, inspiring teammates, and connecting defence to attack through his ball-winning ability.”

“Operating from the half-back line, Dann excels at rebounding the ball from defence to drive Baldivis forward. His composure and delivery from the back are key attributes. Powell brings strength in the air and a penetrating long kick, both powerful weapons in the forward half.”

Men's B Reserves: Swan Athletic vs Mount Lawley

From the Swan Athletic bench, Vice-Captain and hard-running wingman Nick Nott, former Swan Athletic Fairest and Best winner Bill Waideman, and speedy half-forward Sam Hodgkin have been named as three players to watch.

“Nott will look to lead his side to victory after missing out on a chance at premierships glory last year,” Swan Athletic Football Club President Lee Nash explained. “Waideman has put together another stellar season down back and has been miserly towards his opposition, barely conceding a goal all year. Hodgkin is putting together a strong finish to 2025 and will look to cap it off with the ultimate success.”

From Mount Lawley, Captain Chris Barlow has been named as one to watch alongside players Cameron Glass and Jayden Webb. Barlow is renowned for his reliability and solid defence, Glass for his high impact on the ground and for getting the job done, and Webb’s silky-smooth gameplay makes him speedy and dangerous when going for the mark.

Men's C1: Kalamunda vs Melville

From Melville, Cory Olczyk, a medium forward crafty around the goals and a leading goal kicker in the division, Alexander Stewart, a Fairest and Best winner a dominating ruckman, and team Captain Kennedy Sorrell who is strong and brilliant, are three players to watch.

Kalamunda Skipper and 2025 Perth Football League C1 Fairest and Best winner Trent Pottinger, athletic ruckman Cormac White who is known for his elite tap work, and danger in the forward and Perth Football League Colts representative Ashton McGowan have all been named by Kalamunda Districts Football Club President Brenton Lucas as players to watch.

Men's C1 Reserves: Jandakot vs Kalamunda

From the Kalamunda bench, Captain and solid defender Chase Manfield, top utility player Giacomo Paduano, and reliable winger and small forward Curtis Jack have been named as three players to watch.

From Jandakot, players Callum McGuinness, Nick Burrows and Charlie Morgan have been named as ones to watch.

"McGuinness had a stellar year, setting the example for the team from the half-backline and will be all in for a big game," said Jandakot Jets Senior Football Club Registrar David Morgan. "Burrows has had an extremely consistent season... he is a dangerous small forward notching up an impressive 24 goals from his 20 games. Morgan had a consistent year being promoted for a couple of league games. Not the biggest ruckman going around, he catches his opponents off-guard with a gazelle-like leap."

Men's C2: Forrestdale vs Quinns District

From Forrestdale, players Preston Roach, Cheyenne Little and Captain Jayden Little have been named as three to watch.

"Preston's performances in big games have been very good," Forrestdale Football Club President Marika Glover had to say. "An elusive productive forward, Preston has been building up nicely... and is primed for another big grand final display."

Captain Jayden Little has "lead from the front [and] again, like most of the team, is primed for the big games" while Cheyenne, a new recruit this season, has excelled all year and will bring everything to the field this Saturday.

From the Quinns District bench, James King, Jack Deighton and Michael Robertson are three players to keep an eye out for on Saturday.

"King is a 245-game veteran of the club and a three-time premiership player," Quinns District Amateur Football Club President Ian Lee had to say, "a defender who takes big -

marks... hitting his target with effectiveness and accuracy.”

Robertson, a 239-game legend, is described as a “defender who will make it tough for any forward” whilst Deighton, a 217-game veteran and two-time premiership player, is a “tough player that will take care of any forward as he locks down, stopping them from getting their hands on the footy.”

Men's C2 Reserves: Kingsley vs Forrestdale

Josh ‘Newy’ Newman, Craig ‘Scoffo’ Scoffern, and Nick Armour are three Kingsley players to look forward to watching this Saturday.

“Newman is the C2 Reserves [2025] Best and Fairest winner for a reason,” said Kingsley Amateur Football Club Vice-President Ashleigh-Jade Cox. “Captain for a reason, he brings his teammates along for the ride and sets the tone with the way he puts his head over it all day.”

Scoffern, last season’s C2 Reserves Best and Fairest winner, is a dominant ruck known for taking big grabs and fighting for the ball all game. Armour, described as one of the “best interceptors in the competition”, is a player who always positions himself in the right spot, takes intercepting marks, and starts the rebound and transition back the other way. From the Forrestdale bench, players Stevie Farmer, Greg Row and Kaiden Miller are ones to keep an eye on.

“Farmer is a great club and family man who can play both forward and in defence,” said Forrestdale Football Club President Marika Glover. As the reigning club Best and Fairest, he’s known for getting around it, especially for the big games like this weekend’s Grand Final.

“Row flies under the radar but is super important to the team... has great speed and skill, goes hard all day and leaves nothing in the tank. Miller has shown his ability all season in Colts and the senior sides and is a huge player of the future for Forrestdale!”

EGT Drew Banfield Colts: Mount Lawley vs Wanneroo

From Mount Lawley, goal-kicking superstar Carl Morrison, handy winger Talan Rankin, hardworking midfielder Jack Zagar, and top-notch defender Matty Jenkins have been named as players to watch.

Tama Poharama, Riley Crane and Bryce Barrett are three players to watch from the Wanneroo bench.

“Poharama is as smooth as they come with ball in hand, yet uncompromisingly tough at the contest,” Wanneroo Football Club President Craig Sadler explained. “He has built his reputation on combining flair with fight, and it’s exactly that blend that makes him one of the most dangerous and watchable players heading into the biggest game of the season.”

“Crane has the size to impose himself in contests, but what sets him apart is his versatility. Barrett, a first-year colt has quickly made himself impossible to ignore. Blessed with great athleticism and a sharp football IQ, Barrett has adapted to Colts footy with the composure of a seasoned campaigner.”

EGT Ian Dargie Colts: Gosnells vs Kalamunda

From Kalamunda, Zaid Buckland, a key defender and inceptor who is elite by foot, inside mid and clearance winner Michael De Gasperis, and quick-thinking small defender/inside mid Ben Shanahan are three players to watch.

From Gosnells, Marquell Spratt, Corey Bertram Jr. and Beau Smith have been named as players to keep an eye on.

“Spratt is as electrifying on the ground as he is dangerous in the air,” Gosnells Football Club President Brayden Watkins explain. “Bertram Jr. is a contested ball beast. His strong tackling and ball accumulation is always dangerous. Smith is a strong bodied key defender who crashes packs and wins his contests.”

EGT Laurie Keene Colts: Kingsley vs Piara Waters

From the Piara Waters side, players Ryan Jones, Jack Hawtin and Ben McLauchlan have been named as three to watch.

“Jones is an excellent decision maker with a beautiful left foot,” Piara Waters Football Club President Jo Gallagher had to say. “Hawtin, a really talented big forward, has an amazing set of hands in the air but also a huge work rate at ground level for a player his size. McLauchlan is another absolute talent who can have a huge impact on the game at either end of the ground.”

Captain James ‘Jimmy’ Evans and players Joseph ‘Joey’ Franchina and Isaac ‘Pricey’ Price have been named as ones to keep an eye on from the Kingsley bench.

“Evans leads from the front and plays a pivotal role down back,” said Kingsley Amateur Football Club Vice-President Ashleigh-Jade Cox. “Franchina, [runner up] association Best and Fairest even after time off with an injury sets the tone in the midfield with his contested work and work rate. Price can set a game alight with his run and jump; a dangerous and exciting forward.”
